WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

A. Posted Snow Emergency Arteries (Ordinance citation)

Sec. 10-99 Parking on snow emergency arteries.

(a) Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter whenever snow or ice accumulates to a depth of two (2) inches or more, or whenever a snow emergency exists due to impending or existing snow or ice conditions, no person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in his name to park upon the following ways or parts thereof which are hereby designated as "Emergency Arteries" until the way or portion thereof used for vehicular travel has been cleared of snow or ice by city snow removal forces to within twelve (12) inches of the curblines within such public way or part thereof:

- Beacon Street, both sides, between Broadway and Chestnut Street.
- Broadway, both sides entire length from Chelsea-Revere boundary to the Mystic River.
- Central Avenue, both sides, between Hawthorne Street and Eastern Avenue.
- City Hall Avenue, both sides, between Broadway and Chestnut Street.
- Congress Avenue, both sides, between Pearl Street and Broadway.
- Eastern Avenue, both sides, between Louis Street and Broadway.
- Everett Avenue, both sides between Broadway and the Chelsea/Everett boundary line.
- Fifth Street, both sides, between Broadway and Arlington Street.
- Fourth Street, both sides, between Chestnut Street and Pearl Street.
- Garfield Avenue, both sides between the Revere Beach Parkway and Washington Avenue.
- Hawthorne Street, both sides between Bellingham Square and Central Street.
- Marginal Street, both sides, between Pearl Street and Eastern Avenue.
- Nichols Street, both sides between Washington Avenue and Everett City Line.
- Park Street, both sides between Williams Street and Hawthorne Street.

- Pearl Street, both sides, between Congress Avenue and the Chelsea-Boston boundary line.
- Sagamore Avenue, both sides, between Washington Avenue and Garfield Avenue.
- Second Street, both sides, between Park/Winnisimmet Streets and the Chelsea-Everett line.
- Third Street, both sides, between Broadway and the Everett Avenue.
- Washington Avenue, both sides, between Broadway and Chelsea – Revere Boundary Line.
- Webster Avenue, both sides, between Eastern Avenue and the Revere Beach Parkway.
- Williams Street, both sides, between Pearl Street and Spruce Street.

(b) The provisions of this section shall be effective only during such time that official traffic signs are erected to notify operators of the provisions of this section. Whoever violates the provisions of this section shall be liable to charges for the removal and storage of the vehicles as well as subject to punishment by fine. (1966 Cum.
