

assessment systems, prekindergarten-through-grade 12; establish program evaluations; oversee school and district development and implementation of Accelerated Improvement Planning (AIP); alongside the Superintendent and her team, lead the development and implementation of school and district long-range plans. Supervision and evaluation of academic coordinators; oversight of academic related projects including academic purchases and pilot initiatives; district liaison to SDP; monitor student achievement; advise the Superintendent in all matters of policy, practice, and student achievement; and otherwise support the district's mission and priorities.
