What is Homework Help?

A Chelsea Community Schools initiative designed to improve the academic performance of students in grades 5–8 who attend the Chelsea Public Schools.

Partnership with Phi Iota Alpha

Homework Help is a service project of the Nu Chapter of Phi Iota Alpha at Boston University, the nation's oldest Latino fraternity.

Brothers recruit tutors from the Boston University student body and other local universities.



Program Options

In-Class Tutoring

Tutors volunteer in a middle school classroom providing students with academic support.

Afterschool Tutoring

Tutors assist students with class assignments to reinforce academic skills.

Tutor Training

Tutors receive mandatory training to identify and develop students' strengths and interests. Sessions are interactive and review middle school curriculum content in Math and English Language Arts. Professionals in the field of education will discuss techniques for creating a stimulating learning environment.



Our Students

- 1,614 in grades 5–8
- 80.1% of those students are multilingual
- 87.5% come from low-income families
